ABORIGINAL EXHIBIT SPACE

This First Annual Gathering will be an important representation of Mi'kmaq Culture shown through traditional and contemporary music and dance, drum groups, art and crafts. Aboriginal people of different tribal affiliations from Newfoundland and Labrador, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island and Quebec, as well as non-aboriginal people, will come together in a five day event that that will be a cultural experience as well as a festive occasion.

BOOTH FEE FOR VENDORS - POWWOW DAYS – July 11th and 12th , 2009

\$ 100.00 per day. A completed application and a non-refundable **50% deposit** must be received by **May 30th, 2006**. Balance is payable upon your arrival. Space is limited so reserve early for prime locations.

EXHIBITION SPACE

Exhibitors will receive an 8'x10' booth. Tables, Chairs, and displays are responsibility of vendor. The BSGCRC Committee will assign display areas according to receipt of applications and fees. Vendors must provide their own power supply.

RULES

- No sacred pipes may be displayed and no eagle feathers or parts from endangered species may be offered for sale.
- Booths must be manned throughout hours of operation and all table covers must be flame retardant.

ELIGIBILITY

Artists, Craftsmen and commercial food vendors may apply.

Artists and Craftsmen are asked to submit digital photos or print photos of the products they will be selling. All items must be hand crafted in Canada and authentic.

Food Vendors are asked to list food items they will be selling.

Selection of Vendors

Priority will be given as follows:

- ⊇ Mi'kmaq living in the Bay St. George and Port au Port area
- ⊇ Mi'kmaq living in Newfoundland and Labrador
- ⊇ Mi'kmaq living outside of province
- ⊇ First Nations people outside of Newfoundland and Labrador
- ⊇ Non-aboriginal vendors
